

HAMIOTA MUNICIPALITY

BY-LAW No. 8/2016

Being a By-law of Hamiota Municipality repealing business assessment and discontinuing the imposition of business taxes in the former Rural Municipality of Hamiota

WHEREAS Subsection 28 of *The Municipal Assessment Act* provides authority for a council, by by-law, to provide for business assessments;

AND WHEREAS Subsection 306 of *The Municipal Act* provides authority for municipalities that have enacted business assessment by-laws to pass by-laws setting a business rate and imposing business tax each year;

AND WHEREAS the former Rural Municipality of Hamiota enacted by-laws authorizing business assessments and imposing business taxes;

AND WHEREAS the Town of Hamiota did not enact by-laws authorizing business assessments and imposing business taxes;

AND WHEREAS the Rural Municipality of Hamiota and the Town of Hamiota amalgamated, effective January 1, 2015;

AND WHEREAS the Council of Hamiota Municipality deems it in the best interest of the municipality to cancel business assessments and to discontinue the imposition of business taxes in the former Rural Municipality of Hamiota;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the by-law of the former Rural Municipality of Hamiota authorizing business assessment be and hereby is repealed and the imposition of business taxes is hereby discontinued.
