PW Casual Grader Operator Jim Hunkin has started as a casual grader operator. He is currently working evenings and weekends up to 40 hours a week. Our regular operators will be working 45 hours a week. Safety Committee Safety Committee went through training last week with MB Heavy Construction Representative. **Road Reconstruction** Ken reported that the repair to Municipal Road 134 PW W between 355 East and 82N will be approximately 200 feet in length. We will use tire shred. Tom to inquire with Tire Stewardship about funding. PW Drainage New culvert and gate has been installed in Six Mile Slough Municipal Road 86N. There is some water along the runway and we will need to undertake a survey to establish how to correct it. PW Gravelling There is going to be additional material required to get the roads back in shape. Committee recommended doing what is necessary to get them back in shape. Willow Heights We need to do something about the terrain in the PW subdivision and needs to be levelled. It was agreed that a breaking disc would probably work best. PW will inquire about getting one. West Shop Yard We looked at doing what we could to fix the parking Budget lot which is currently impassable. The Department agreed that it would be better to hire the right equipment. It should be a 2017 budget item. PW **Entrance Signs** We require more stone and the grass cut at both entrance signs. 10:02 AM Delegation: Richard Richard inquired about getting permission to clear Council & Arnold the brush along Municipal Road 141W between PR CAO 355 West and Municipal Road and 87N. Also along 135W between PR 355 and 85N. Richard was
