• <u>9:30 AM Barb Kingdon, Water Resource Officer, MB Conservation</u> and Water Stewardship – Licencing process

She is working with municipalities to redefine how things are done and hopefully make the system more efficient. The use of GPS for identifying location of works is important. Barb took a few minutes to go over the local enforcement and licencing issues with Council – she reminded everyone that all water control works require a licence.

• <u>10:30 AM Richard Arnold, Randy Lints & George Rogers - Pumping of water</u>

The delegation appeared before Council to discuss the large amount of water that has accumulated along PR 355 on NE 8-15-24 WPM. Richard is proposing to pump the water to the ravine to the east and on to the Arrow River. The body of water used to be 30 acres in size and is now over 100 and it is causing problems with the road and neighboring properties because it is running where it wants and then does not get away. Richard is proposing to pay for the fuel to pump the water if the municipality would supply the tractor and pump since the water is affecting the road and neighboring properties. It would also be beneficial if the municipality were to apply for the temporary licence to pump.

A brief discussion ensued and Council indicated they would consider all of the requests and thanked the delegation for their time.
