HAMIOTA MUNICIPALITY

BY-LAW NO. 8/2018

Being a By-law of the Hamiota Municipality to ensure the maintenance and legibility of a civic numbering sign system.

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient and advisable to pass a By-law to provide generally for the protection of life and property from damages by fire and to regulate burning within Hamiota Municipality.

WHEREAS Section 232 (1) of The Municipal Act provides that a Council may pass By-laws for municipal purposes respecting the following matters pertaining to:

- (a) The safety, health, protection and well being of people, and the safety and protection of property
- (d) Municipal roads, including naming the roads, posting the names on public or private property, and numbering lots and buildings along the roads
- (f) Property adjacent to highways or municipal roads, whether the property is publicly or privately owned
- NOW THEREFORE the Council of Hamiota Municipality in session assembled enacts as follows;
 - THAT Hamiota Municipality shall install the post and number sign, in such a manner that the numbers be visible from the municipal or provincial road;
 - THAT the initial cost of installation of the post and number sign be the responsibility of Hamiota Municipality;
 - THAT the numbering system is established in accordance with The Civic Addressing Standard For Manitoba;
 - THAT the numbering system signs erected by Hamiota Municipality be kept in a legible condition at all times;
 - THAT the blade of the sign be parallel to the ground;
 - . THAT the number sign be placed off the edge of the municipal right-of-way.
 - THAT the numbering system signs erected by Hamiota Municipality be kept free of obstructions (including snow drift) and in plain view at all times;
- I. THAT numbering system signs and posts shall be the property of Hamiota Municipality;
- THAT the property owner be responsible to immediately notify Hamiota Municipality if a numbering sign or post is damaged or missing;
- 0. THAT the maintenance and repair of the numbering sign and post be the responsibility of Hamiota Municipality;
- 1. THAT the cost of maintenance and repair of the numbering sign and post be the responsibility of the property owner;
- 2. THAT if a property owner requests a sign be placed on a non-designated site or abandoned farm site the cost of the sign, post and installation shall be the responsibility of the property owner.
- 3. THAT the property owner be given 30 days notice to make payment upon presentation of an invoice for the costs of the maintenance and repair of the numbering sign and post. Failure to make payment within the 30 days specified will result in an outstanding debt to Hamiota Municipality and can be collected in the same manner as a tax may be collected or enforced under the Municipal Act.
